

On page 6 of this bulletin is the basic financial comparison between 2021 and 2022. As you can see, the finances at OLHC remained pretty steady. Expenses went up in 2022 but so did revenues. Revenues are explained with a 4.5% increase in donations, some losses in special collections for Christmas and Easter and Fundraising Programs and receiving 321K in rental income. We are grateful for the presence of the James P. Murphy Preparatory School in our parish. Expenses come from increased costs due to supply chain issues and inflation. Also some necessary renovation work was done in the rectory and school. The biggest increase was in the Archdiocesan Cathedraticum Tax and School Support which results from greater incomes. Overall, our parish continues in a healthy direction. I am grateful to God for your continued generosity and I entrust the future to His Divine Providence.

Also I would like to start introducing 2023 as our 125th Anniversary Year. We will give a list of different celebrations that will happen throughout the year. Right now, I ask that you save two dates:
