

## Rosary to Our Lady of Fatima

Ash Wednesday this year is February 14th. In our culture, this day is known as Valentine's Day, which is based off the feast day of an early Roman saint named St. Valentine. St. Valentine was a Roman priest who lived in the 3rd century who was killed for his faith near Rome. Legend says that he secretly married Christians couples during persecution and this led to his arrest and execution. February 14th is the day that St. Valentine died. As we know, Valentine's day has become very commercialized, making a special dinner or going out to a restaurant. Due to Ash Wednesday this year which falls on Valentine's day, it is a day of fasting and abstinence. THERE ARE NO DISPENSATIONS. Allow me to suggest that if you desire to honor your loved one for Valentine's Day, that you translate the festivities to another day BEFORE Ash Wednesday.

While we are on the subject of Ash Wednesday, it is good to remind everyone that if someone is sick, please do NOT come with an envelope or some other container for them to receive ashes. If someone truly can't come and receive ashes in Church, more important is that you call and arrange for a priest like me to come and give them the sacraments such as confession, anointing, and communion. The sacraments would truly help their soul be right with God, which is the true spirit of Lent, much more than the reception of blessed ashes. The value of receiving ashes is more in the disposition of the person who comes to receive them and their act of faith and repentance, more than the ashes themselves. If someone cannot come, they are not obliged. Instead, arrange a home visit so they can truly get the spiritual blessing they need, God's grace through the sacraments.
