

Last week I discussed briefly as part of my homily the National Eucharistic Revival being promoted by the Bishop of the United States. If you want to learn more about it, please go to: eucharsticrevival.org. I wanted to share with you the 7 points I mentioned in my homily that are ways we can enliven our own faith in the Eucharist and reap more spiritual rewards from it:

- 1.) Reverence at Mass. No talking before, during and after mass in the church. Let the church serve its primary function, to be a place of prayerful encounter with the Lord.
- 2.) Genuflection when entering and exiting the presence of the Lord in the tabernacle at the center of the Church. (if your knees don't work, than at least bow).
- 3.) Observing the Eucharistic Fast: no eating or drinking (except water and essential medicine) one hour before receiving the Eucharist.
- 4.) Examination of Conscience: not going to Holy Communion in the state of mortal sin. This also applies to those who live in irregular marriages or in a state of cohabitation. It is important to remember that participating in the Mass in itself is all that is required to fulfill our duty towards God on Sunday. Reception of Holy Communion is a very personal and important decision. Steps must be taken to reconcile with God and thus avoid the sin of sacrilege before we receive Holy Communion. We give more honor to God by spiritual participation in the Mass alone than by receiving unworthily.
- 5.) Receiving Holy Communion reverently: In my opinion, the most preferred method of receiving communion is on the tongue. Its the safest, the most universal, and better prevents profanation. However, the bishops of the United States allow communion on the hand. If you choose to use the hand, make sure it is done with reverence for the real presence of Christ. It is not proper to take the host to your pew for consumption. It should be consumed in the presence of the priest.
- 6.) Making a thanksgiving after receiving Holy Communion: This should be done when you return to your pew. A very beautiful practice is to spend time after the Mass to extend the time to pray in thanksgiving.
- 7.) Adoring the Blessed Sacrament outside of the celebration of Mass, especially in making visits to the church to pray: Allowing time to sit in quiet before the Lord's presence in the tabernacle will deepen our love for Him and strengthen our resolve to stay away from sin and serve Him alone.

The Golden Jubilee Mass is for couples celebrating 50 years of marriage during 2023.


