

Last weekend in our parish we remembered the 125th Anniversary of our parish with a special Mass with our Archbishop, Cardinal Timothy Dolan. When we think of 125 years, we think of all the generations of people that have come through our parish, who have lived and died under her spiritual care. This parish has been a sign of hope and an anchor of our community in the turbulent storms of the periods of history through which it has lived. Why has it been so? Not so much because there have been great priests, or wonderful people, as surely there have been, but because of God, whose power has worked through human instruments to bring the salvation of Christ to the people of Tottenville.

At the Mass, we were blessed to have with us, Bishop Peter Byrne, Episopal Vicar of Staten Island and Pastor of Blessed Sacrament Church, Bishop Thomas Deenihan, Bishop Meath in Ireland, Msgr. William Belford, Dean of Staten Island and Pastor of St. Teresa Church. Also with us were Fr. Jarlath Quinn and Fr. Frank Dias, former pastors of OLHC, with Father Michael Reilly, Principal of St. Joseph by-the-Sea High School, Fr. John Wroblewski, Pastor of Our Lady of Pity-St. Anthony Parish, Fr. Fredy Patino, Fr. Stephen Ries and Fr. Frank Naccarato. These priests who celebrated and prayed with us remind us that a parish has effects beyond itself. When God is praised, the whole world is better for it.

Also the Cardinal was able to bless our newly restored monument to those who died on September 11, 2001. I am grateful to Brian Hall, from Joseph G. Hall and Sons Monuments, for donating the stone. I am grateful to Michael Daragjati, from Four Bridges Construction, for all his efforts as well as Gerard Chipura.

Allow me to thank Arthur McCarthy, from Mammoth Construction, for helping to repair the church ceiling. Vincent D'Esposito helped get the lights in the School Gym ready. John and Rose Argenziano helped with preparing the sanctuary. Also allow me to thank Nilda Peterson for her help, and Charles Carletto and Lenny D'Ambrosia for illustrating the history of our parish on the projection screens. Thank you, as well, to our altar servers who gave their time to make the ceremony extra special and to all those who volunteered.

Lastly, allow me to acknowledge the help of OLHC's staff: Ninfa Chiarello, Maria Byrnes, Joan Baggs, Patricia Dresch and Chandika Lansa. Their help was indispensable. Thank you to Deacon John Singler for his presence and guidance, Matthew Hosmer, our music director.

As we mark this anniversary, my prayer is that by remembering God's providence in the past, we will be able to face the present and build a future because we know God will continue to be with us if we continue to have faith in Him.


