

#### Rosary to Our Lady of Fatima

The 13th of every month at 6:00 pm



Here are some points on which we could all improve upon. I printed this about a month ago and I think that this can also apply to this Sunday's Feast Corpus Christi. I am also adding a few new ones at the end as extra food for thought. The more we revere the Blessed Sacrament, the more our lives will be directed toward love, prayer, and eternity.

- 1.) Reverence at Mass. No talking before, during and after mass in the church. Let the church serve its primary function, to be a place of prayerful encounter with the Lord.
- 2.) Performing a genuflection when entering and exiting the presence of the Lord in the tabernacle at the center of the Church. This acknowledges God's presence in a tangible way (if your knees don't work, then at least bow.)
- 3.) Observing the Eucharistic Fast: no eating or drinking (except water and essential medicine) one hour before receiving the Eucharist.
- 4.) Examination of Conscience: Refraining from Holy Communion in the state of mortal sin. This also applies to those who live in irregular marriages or in a state of cohabitation. It is important to remember that participating in the Mass in itself is all that is required to fulfill our duty towards God on Sunday. Reception of Holy Communion is a very personal and important decision. Steps must be taken to reconcile with God and thus avoid the sin of sacrilege before we receive Holy Communion. We give more honor to God by spiritual participation in the Mass alone than by receiving unworthily.
- 5.) Receiving Holy Communion reverently: In my opinion, the most preferred method of receiving communion is on the tongue. Its the safest, the most universal, and better prevents profanation. However, the bishops of the United States allow communion on the hand. If you choose to use the hand, make sure it is done with reverence for the real presence of Christ. It is not proper to take the host to your pew for consumption. It should be consumed in the presence of the priest.
- 6.) Making a thanksgiving after receiving Holy Communion: This should be done when you return to your pew. A very beautiful practice is to spend time after the Mass to extend the time to pray in thanksgiving.
- 7.) Adoring the Blessed Sacrament outside of the celebration of Mass, especially in making visits to the church to pray: Allowing time to sit in quite before the Lord's presence in the tabernacle will deepen our love for Him and strengthen our resolve to stay away from sin and serve Him alone.
- 8.) Sign of Peace is an option: the priest may or may not invite you to the sign of peace. At this parish, this option is not being chosen for the purpose of not breaking a reverent ambience before the Blessed Sacrament. It is an option that is not integral to the mass. I hope more of you will choose reverence inside the church and warm affection for family and friends afterwards.
- 9.) Modest and Respectful Dress: One of the ways we get ourselves ready for Church is our physical appearance. The best way to dress for Church is to dress as you would to see the doctor. Summer is a time that people natural wear less. In Church this should be balanced with a sense of reverence and modesty because of the activity in which we are engaged: Worshipping God. Modest means dressing in a way that does not draw attention to the body for the propose of gaining the attention of others. Respectful means wearing clothes that are appropriate. Gym shorts, short shorts, undershirts, or tank tops may be appropriate for the beach or gym but follow below this standard in regards to Church.
