

A Reflection of Today's Gospel: Matthew 15-21-28



The Gospel reading of Matthew 15:21–28 shares how God's salvation plan is unlimited. Although the Gospel is primarily for the Jews, it is also for the Gentiles. Through the confession of sins and belief in the saving work of God's son, Jesus Christ, both Jews and Gentiles receive His gift of salvation.

When Jesus encounters the Canaanite woman with the demon-possessed daughter, the Jews presume that this woman is unacceptable to the Lord because of her Gentile heritage. Jesus acknowledges her faith and heals her daughter. This event is a fulfillment of Isaiah: righteousness comes from the Lord and is manifested in love and obedience.

Although the Canaanite woman comes to Jesus in humility, she speaks assertively, saying, "have mercy on me". She is certain not only of His divine power but also His merciful willingness to use that power to help her. Naturally, this sure faith is worked by the Holy Spirit, as Jesus comments, "you have great faith!"

The woman's daughter was healed from that hour.

Do we have faith? Do we sometimes question our Lord when we are in despair? It is when we are in times of trouble that our faith in Jesus will help us get through the struggles we encounter in our every day lives.

Jesus will always have mercy on us. May we always have faith in Our Lord Jesus Christ.

THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY



The month of August is dedicated to the Immaculate Heart. The physical heart of Mary is venerated (and not adored as the Sacred Heart of Jesus is) because it is united to her person and is the seat of her love (especially for her divine Son), virtue and inner life.

This devotion has received new emphasis in this century from the visions given to Lucy Dos Santos, oldest of the visionaries of Fatima, in her convent in Tui, in Spain in 1925 and 1926. In the visions, Our Lady asked for the practice of the Five First Saturdays to help make amends for the offenses committed against her heart by the blasphemies and ingratitude of men. The practice parallels the devotion of the Nine First Fridays in honor of the Sacred Heart.

On October 31, 1942, Pope Pius XII made a solemn Act of Consecration of the Church and the whole world to the Immaculate heart.

Let us remember this devotion yearround, but particularly through the month of August.


