

A reflection of today's Gospel

The Gospel of Matthew 18: 15-20

In today's Gospel Jesus speaks to us about when we are in confrontation with others. When you do not agree with that person, are you responsible for that person? Yes, we are responsible for one another. In this Gospel, Jesus outlines to us how we can address our offenders, privately and with others.

We all experience disagreements with others at one time or another in our lives. Jesus says to address it privately. If that does not seem to work, to take 2 others to listen to the situation. You can also drop it. However, if you drop it, don't raise drama with others by gossiping or holding on to bitterness. If he hears you, you gained your brother.

Jesus does not give authority to one only. When others examine the situation, they can hear both sides and then if the person is in the wrong and does not recognize this it is only then that they may regarded as wrong. However, you still must love them in the name of Jesus. You do not have permission to hate them. In Jesus' name you must always pray for them and love them.

There is great power when we come together as a community and pray for each person in spite of our wrong doings. We are a family of believers in our church community. God never intended for us to live our Catholic life in isolation. He wants us to live as a community of our faith. We come together in prayer.

May we all reflect on the Church Hymn:

"We are a pilgrim people, we are the church of God.

A family of believers, disciples of the Lord.

United in one Spirit, ignited by the fire.

Still burning through the ages

Still present in our lives."

Importantly, it is the community of God in which we constantly seek the mind of Christ. We are gathered in His name, Jesus Christ, Our Lord.
