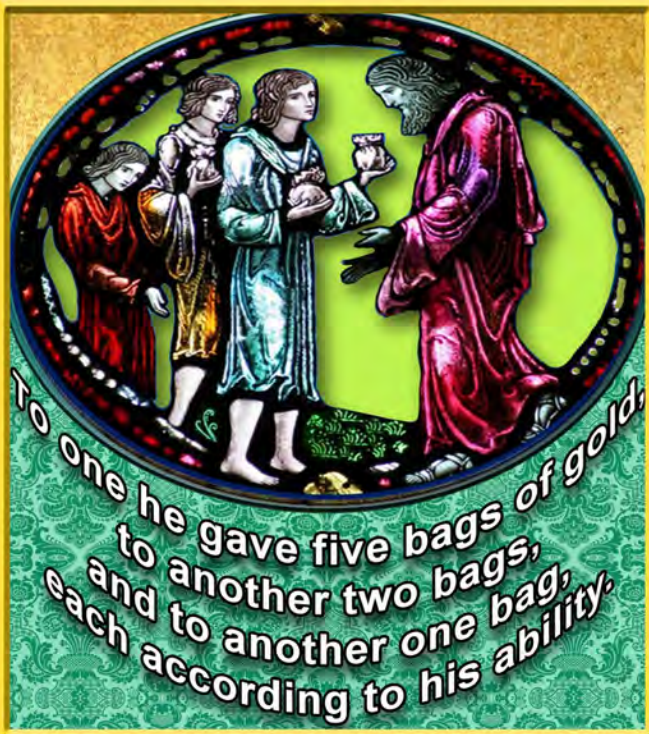

SACRAMENTS
