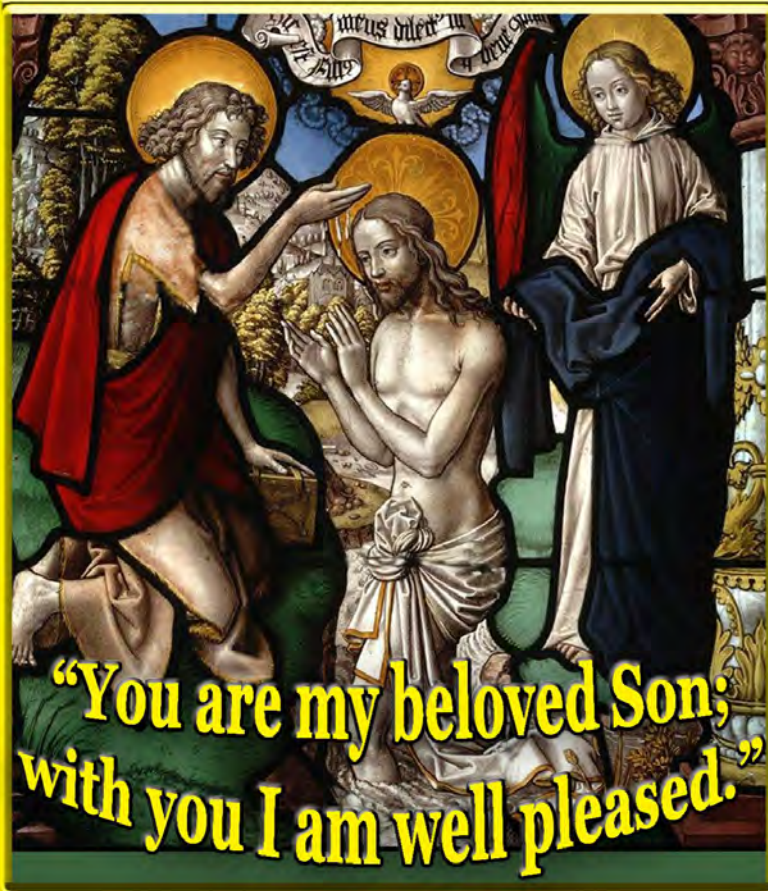

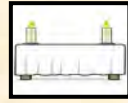
Sick List: Please update us monthly.

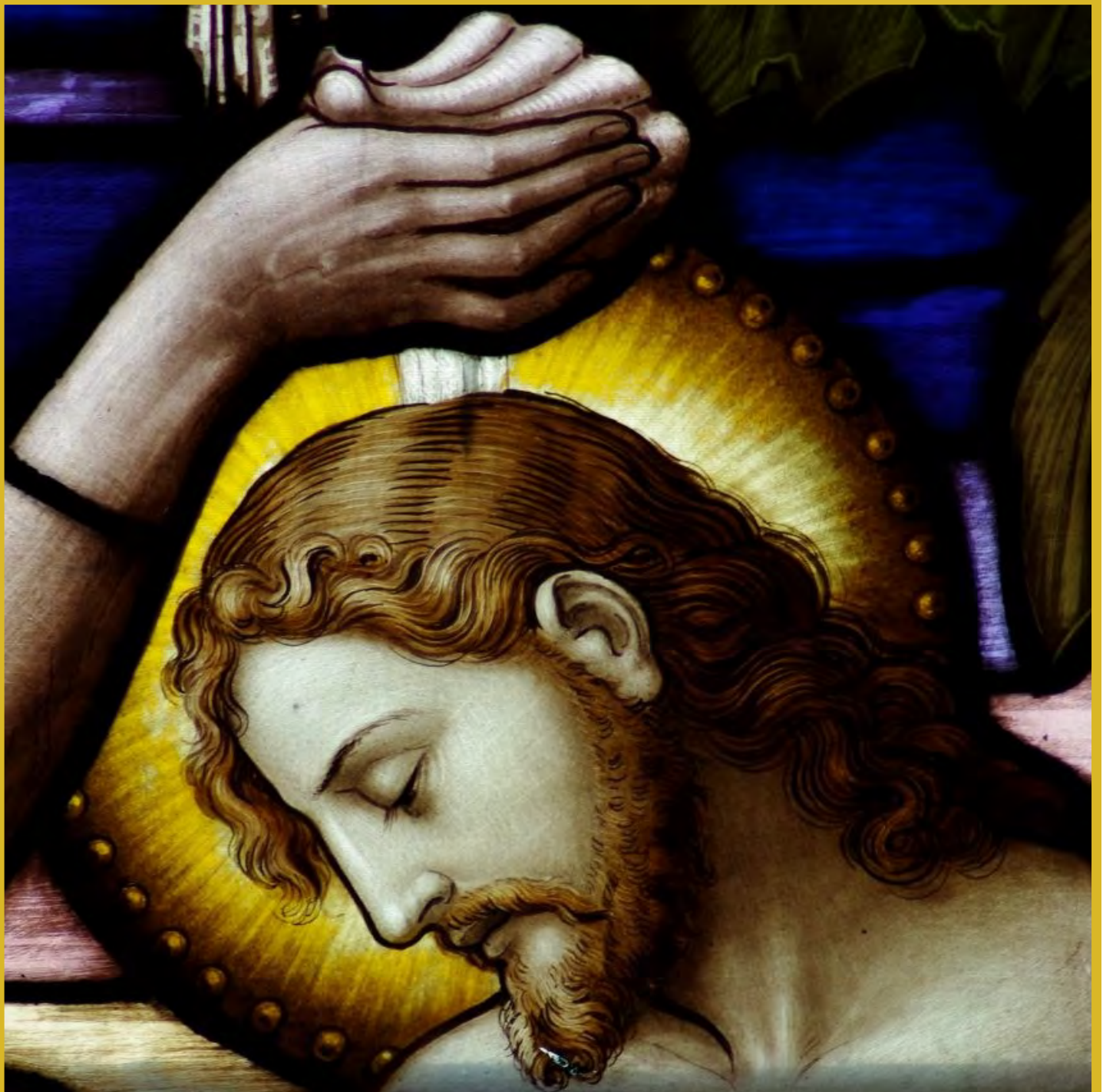
