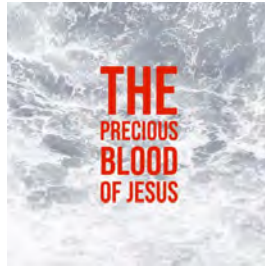

July is the month dedicated to the Precious Blood of Jesus in the Liturgical calendar of the Church. Devotion to the Precious Blood has deep historical roots, dating back to the early centuries of Christianity. During the month of July it is our time to deepen our devotion to Jesus and to reflect on the salvific power of His Blood. It offers us an opportunity to participate in special prayers, Liturgies, and devotional practices focused on the Precious Blood.

Redemption

The Precious Blood of Jesus is seen as the ultimate expression of God's love and mercy, as it was freely given for the forgiveness of sins and the salvation of souls. This devotion is powerful as it is the ultimate expression of His love and mercy toward us. By shedding His Blood, Jesus conquered the powers of sin and death, offering believers the hope of new life and reconciliation with God.

The Precious Blood has the power to intercede for believers and offer us protection from spiritual harm. We often invoke the Precious Blood for strength, healing, and deliverance from evil.

Divine Mercy connection

Devotion to the Precious Blood of Jesus is seen as an essential part of the Divine Mercy Chaplet because it emphasizes the redemptive and atoning power of Jesus' sacrifice. The Precious Blood of Jesus, shed for the forgiveness of sins, is central to the Divine Mercy message, which highlights God's mercy and forgiveness offered to humanity through the Passion and death of Jesus Christ.

Meditate and reflect

Take the time to meditate on the significance of Jesus' Precious Blood and its role in the redemption of humanity. Regularly participate in the Sacraments of the Eucharist and Reconciliation as it is essential to receive the graces made available through the Precious Blood of Jesus. Approach the Sacraments with a heart open to receiving God's mercy and forgiveness.

Embrace the call to live out the message of Divine Mercy by showing compassion and forgiveness to others. Do acts of mercy to those in need, whether through charitable works, acts of kindness, or offering forgiveness to those who have wronged you. Share the message of God's mercy and the significance of Jesus' Precious Blood with others. Use opportunities for evangelization to proclaim the good news of salvation through Christ's sacrifice and to invite others to experience the transforming power of God's mercy in their lives.

Heal the wounds of our souls and wash away the sins of the whole world.
O Precious Blood, have mercy.

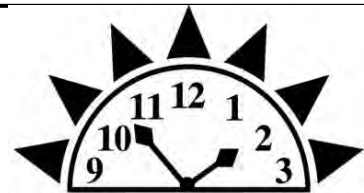

Stop Physician-Assisted Suicide in New York

New York is on the brink of legalizing physician-assisted suicide. Bi l A136 has already passed the Senate and Assembly. The only thing standing in its way is Governor Hochul's veto — and she needs to hear from you. This bi l would allow doctors to prescribe lethal medication with the sole purpose of ending a patient's life. It puts the most vulnerable among us — the elderly, people with disabilities, and those facing emotional or financial despair — at even greater risk. Suicide is not healthcare. We must speak out to protect the dignity of every human life. Assisted suicide is a dangerous and deadly path — one we must not go down. Take Action!
