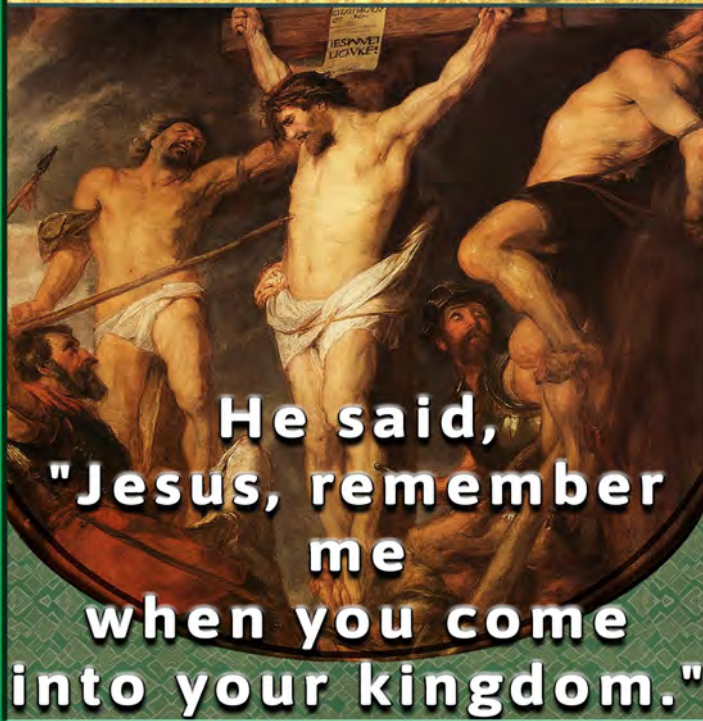

Anointing of the Sick: Call the rectory at any time.

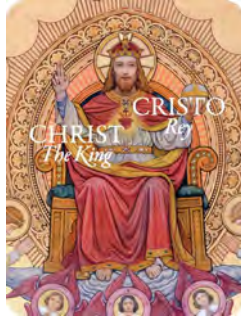

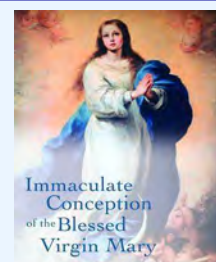
**RESPECT LIFE NEWS**
